Friday, December 4th

Radio City Music Hall

3-night's hotel accommodations, tax included

- You pay one price and your hotel and everything else listed in your package is paid for. All in one simple transaction.
- Hint: The earlier you book your Christmas in New York package, the better rate you will get at your hotel of choice.
- A list of hotel choices will be provided for you to select from. You will have a good amount of flexibility when choosing your hotel. If you have a specific hotel you would like to use in your package, just let us know!
- When your package reservation is complete your hotel will be secured right away and a hotel confirmation number will be given to you.
- Your package includes room and tax only. Incidentals (phone, room service, etc.) are paid for separately by you.

Radio City Music Hall "Stage Door" tour

- The Radio City "Stage Door Tour" is a one hour walking tour of the interior of Radio City Music Hall that departs from the Music Hall lobby. Radio City Music Hall is located in the heart of Rockefeller Center at 1260 Avenue of the Americas (6th Ave and 50th Street).
- Your tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- Reopened after an extensive restoration on October 4, 1999, the Music Hall now reflects its original grandeur of opening night, 1932, sporting behind-the-scenes upgrades and refurbishment. Following the lead of Radio City's experienced tour guides, explore the beautiful art-deco interiors, learn the secrets of the Great Stage, one of the largest indoor performance stages in the world; the stage's hydraulic system, still in operation since the '30s; And as an exciting climax to the Stage Door Tour, guests will meet one of the world-famous Radio City Rockettes.
- Tours are available 7 days a week from 11am to 3pm, every hour on the hour. Your NYC itinerary is flexible and will include your Stage Door tour at a day and time that is *best for you*.
- Please note that if you take a tour during an event, tours may operate with limited access to the auditorium and hydraulics.
- Video cameras and cell phones are not permitted on the tour. Cameras are allowed.

Radio City Music Hall Christmas Spectacular

- To help you get the most value for your dollar, the “budget” version of this package includes the \$52 price-level tickets which still offers good seats with excellent views.
- Your tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- During off-peak performances your seats are in the 2nd mezzanine. During peak performances your seats are in the 3rd mezzanine.
- Christmas Spectacular performances begin on November 7th with the last performances on December 30th.
- Peak performances are on the following dates: November 22nd – 23rd, 27th – 30th and December 6th – 7th, 13th - 14th, 20th – 30th , as well as evening performances on December 5th, 12th and 15th – 19th.
- There are from two to as many as six performances a day with show times in the morning, afternoon and evening.
- If you have a preference you can pick and choose which day and time you would like to attend the show.
- If you wish you may choose to upgrade your seats for an additional cost (this will range from an additional \$20 - \$200 per ticket). Premium seats on peak performances are \$150 or \$250 per ticket (plus service charges). Premium seats for non-peak performances are \$90 (plus service charges).
- Show length is one and a half hours.
- Children 2 and older require a ticket to gain admittance to Radio City Music Hall. Any child who has yet to reach their second birthday does not require a ticket, however, they may not occupy their own separate seat and must sit on a parent or guardian's lap.
- Photography during performances is strictly prohibited. Flash photography is not only distracting to the performers, but to your fellow patrons as well.
- Radio City Music Hall does not have a formal dress code. We do ask, however, that you use your best personal judgement when dressing for an event.

Grayline New York 2-day sightseeing tour

- Your electronic tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- All you need to do is exchange your vouchers for actual tickets at Grayline's convenient Midtown Manhattan ticket office and you're on your way.

- E-tickets give you the added value of security and peace of mind in case you lose your actual tickets. Since we will have additional copies of your tickets on file, we can just e-mail them to you or fax them to your hotel!
- Your tickets are good for 2 *consecutive days* of sightseeing. You may start your tour any day, any time you want during your stay.
- There is a licensed tour guide on board your double-decker bus at all time, pointing out sights and giving you interesting facts and stories about New York as you go along.

Broadway show

- Choose from over 30 shows, from famous Broadway musicals like Lion King, Jersey Boys and Wicked to dramas, comedies, Broadway revivals, and the latest productions to hit the stage.
- Your electronic tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- E-tickets give you the added value of security and peace of mind in case you lose your actual tickets. Since we will have additional copies of your tickets on file, we can just e-mail them to you or fax them to your hotel!
- You may choose which play you want to see. If the show you want is sold-out or only has lesser value seats available, you have the option of either paying a higher per-ticket price for this show (usually \$50 - \$100 more per ticket) or choose a different show. Premium seats to shows - which are the first 10 rows, center stage - are also available for an additional \$100 - \$150 per ticket depending on the show.
- If you have a preference, you may choose which day you would like to see your show. Most theaters are dark on Mondays. Evening performances are at either 7pm or 8pm while matinees are at either 2pm or 3pm (usually on Wednesdays, Saturdays and Sundays).
- The theater does not have a dress code. The majority of people will be slightly dressed up while there will be people wearing jeans or shorts and t-shirts as well.
- All Broadway theaters are located in the Theater District (41st Street to 57th Street between 6th Avenue and 8th Avenue), within easy walking distance to most Midtown Manhattan hotels. Transportation to the theater is not required in most cases and is therefore not included in our packages. Car service can always be arranged upon request.

Tavern on the Green pre-theater dinner

- Location: Central Park West at West 67th Street (inside Central Park).
- Your pre-theater dinner can be reserved on Sundays – Thursdays between 5pm and 6:30pm. If you decide to dine on a Friday or Saturday or after 6:30pm, you may apply your credit for dinner towards your bill. You only pay the difference.
- Your meal includes 3-courses, tax and gratuity. Drinks are paid for separately.
- You will be provided with a letter of pre-payment for you to present to the host/hostess upon your arrival. This will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- Kids menus are available for children under 12.
- Tavern on the Green is reachable most easily by taxi or subway. A taxi would cost approximately \$10 total to get there from most Midtown Manhattan hotels. Subway fare is \$2 per person each way. The restaurant is within walking distance from some hotels.
- A full menu with more items to choose from is also available to you. If you decide to go with this menu then you will receive a credit towards your dinner and you will only have to pay the difference in the bill.

Empire State Building or Top of the Rock Observation Deck

You may choose which observation deck you want to visit. You always have the option of adding in both observatories if you wish.

Empire State Building

- Location: 350 5th Avenue at 34th Street.
- Your tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- The Empire State Building observation deck allows you to visit any day, any time during operating hours, giving you the freedom to decide while you're here when is the best time for you to go. The Observatory's regular hours of operation are: 8:00am to 2:00am 7 days a week, 365 days a year. Last elevators go up at 1:15am.
- The Empire State Building also has a newly re-opened 102nd Floor Observatory. Tickets are only sold upon arrival at the Empire State Building at a cost of \$15.00 in addition to regular admission tickets.
- The Empire State Building's observatory is the tallest in the City (86th floor observatory is 1,050 feet; 320 meters), and is reached by high speed, automatic elevators, has both a glass-enclosed area, which is heated in winter and cooled in summer, and spacious outdoor promenades on all four sides of the Building. High powered binoculars are available on the promenades for the convenience of visitors

at a minimal cost. Souvenir counters are also located in the 86th floor observatory. The 86th floor observatory is handicap accessible.

- ESB Express Pass: \$26 additional per person
The lines at the Empire State Building Observatory are as legendary as the building itself. The line actually consists of 3 different lines. The first one is the security line that everyone must go through. Next comes the ticket line. Visitors with pre-purchased tickets can skip this line which can save a considerable amount of time during our busiest times. The 3rd and last line is for the elevators that take you to the Observatory. By purchasing an Express Pass you will automatically be moved to the front of each and every line.

Top of the Rock

- Location: Entrance on 50th Street between 5th and 6th Avenues. Adjacent to Times Square.
- The Top of the Rock observation deck is our personal favorite and has multi-media historical exhibits, an exciting elevator ride to the top and a unique view of the City.
- Your tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- The Top of the Rock is open from 8am to midnight (last elevator up at 11pm), 365 days a year.
- Since the observation deck at Top of the Rock is on the 70th floor, you have the feeling of being suspended and floating in the middle of the Manhattan skyline. The view of the Empire State Building is picture perfect, as is the rest of the City from this awesome vantage point.
- Top of the Rock requires you to pick a date and time you would like to visit. This reduces the amount of time waiting in line.

NY Waterway 90-minute tour

- Location: New York Waterway – pier 78 at West 38th Street (on the Hudson River)
- Multiple departure times make it easy to fit this must-experience tour into your itinerary. Departure times vary according to the time of year but generally run at 10am, 11am, 12pm 1pm and 2pm all year round.
- Your tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- The boat *does not* stop at the Statue of Liberty or Ellis Island but the tour does give you a breathtaking view of both of these famous landmarks. The sightseeing boat cruise is a great way to see the Statue of Liberty up close without having to wait in long lines.

- All boats have an indoor and outdoor viewing area to accommodate all types of weather.
- Food and refreshments (including beer) are served on board.
- Getting to the pier to take your tour is simple, easy and inexpensive. A taxi from most Midtown Manhattan hotels typically costs no more than \$10 total (per taxi, not per person). *Free* shuttles are available to take you back to Midtown Manhattan.

Metropolitan Museum of Art

- Location: 5th Avenue and 82nd Street.
- Your tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- You can visit the museum any time, any day you wish during your stay. The museum is open Tuesdays through Sundays from 9:30am to 5:30pm; Fridays and Saturdays until 9pm. The museum is closed on December 25th, January 1st and Thanksgiving Day.




Personal Concierge Service

- Your personal concierge is assigned to you the moment you make your reservation and is available to you throughout your stay in New York until the moment you're on your plane to go back home.
- Your concierge can really come in handy when it comes to planning all those things to do that are *outside* of your package. Things like finding the best places to go shopping, what's the best way to get around town, where are the best places to listen to some live music or where to find some great local restaurants.
- Our office hours are Monday through Friday 11am to 7pm and we are on call 24 hours a day as well as throughout the weekend if we are needed.

How It All Works:

Limousine from your airport to your hotel

- Your driver will meet you in the baggage claim area and will be holding a sign with your name on it. A phone number will be provided for you to contact the driver if necessary.

- Your limousine is fully stocked with complimentary refreshments and alcohol.

- All limousines have a privacy divider for your convenience.
- Travel time to your hotel from Newark, JFK and LaGuardia airports is approximately 1 hour in normal traffic.
- Tolls are included.
- Gratuity to the driver is not included. An average tip for an airport transfer is \$20.

Dinner at the Sea Grill Restaurant

- The Sea Grill restaurant is located at 19 West 49th Street between 5th and 6th Avenues and is within easy walking distance to most Midtown Manhattan hotels, or just a short cab ride away. Transportation to and/or from the restaurant is always available upon request for an additional charge.
- Your meal includes three sumptuous courses as well as tax and gratuity. Drinks are paid for separately.
- You may choose the day and time you would prefer to dine and your concierge will flawlessly work it into your itinerary.
- No vouchers are needed. Just arrive at the restaurant and give your name to the host or hostess and you will be seated. All arrangements have been made for you.
- Dress code is business casual. Jackets are preferred for gentlemen. No jeans or sneakers.

Four-hour private City tour

- You will have a separate tour guide from your driver. Your driver *is not* your guide.
- You get to choose your vehicle. Limousines are great when you want to impress or want that added sense of luxury and come standard with refreshments at no extra charge. Vans are perfect for sightseeing with their much larger windows and are a lot easier to get in and out of. Vans are also ideal for parties of more than 4 people. Luxury sedans (such as a Lincoln Town Car or Mercedes) are good for 2 people. SUVs are fun as an additional option and have large windows and are a little higher up off the ground so you can see a bit more.
- You can take your tour any day, any time you want. We recommend taking it the day after you arrive so you become more familiar with the City right away. Then you can spend the rest of your trip going back and spending more time at those places you enjoyed most during your tour.
